<p><b>Details of project</b> (up to 500 words): Include when the project is expected to be completed by.</p> <p><b>We fly 365 days a year and attend on average 3 missions a day, each mission is a cost to the charity of approximately £2000 , and regularly fly into the area to attend those incidents where speed is vital to the outcome of the patients survival.</b> <b>The Thames Valley Air Ambulance carries a wide range of life saving equipment to enable our highly trained crew to provide swift pre emergency intervention on the ground and in the air. We have the ability to land in inaccessible places, a key asset given the many areas that a conventional land ambulance would struggle to reach, and are often scrambled to equestrian, farm and walking incidents as well as major medical emergencies and serious road traffic incidents where the benefit of the Air Ambulance means it can fly over stationary traffic, thus ensuring the patient is in hospital within the crucial Golden Hour- the period immediately following a serious injury or onset of a serious medical emergency and is the most critical period in the patients survival.</b></p>
