Note: 59A relates to the duty to pass the local CIL portion to local councils. 59B governs CIL paid through land or infrastructure and where payments to a local council must be paid in money. 59(4) relates to passing CIL to another person for that person to apply to funding the provision, improvement, replacement, operation or maintenance of infrastructure
