Local Audit and Accountability Act 2014, Sections 25 to 28

Accounts and Audit (England) Regulations 2015, Sections 10, 14, 15 and 17

The Council's accounts are subject to external audit by KPMG LLP of 3 Assembly Square, Britannia Quay, Cardiff CF10 4AX. Members of the public and local government electors have certain rights in the audit process:

1. From 1st June 2018 to 12th July 2018 between 9am and 4.45pm any person may inspect the accounts of the Council for the year ended 2017/18 and certain related documents (comprising books, deeds, contracts, bills, vouchers and receipts) at the address given below. They may also make copies of the accounts and documents.
2. From 1st June 2018 to 12th July 2018 a local government elector for the area of the Council, or his/her representative, may ask the auditor questions about the accounts. Please contact the auditor Ian Pennington at the address given above to make arrangements to ask any questions.
3. From 1st June 2018 to 12th July 2018 a local government elector for the area of the Council, or his/her representative, may object to the Council's accounts (under section 27 of the Local Audit and Accountability Act 2014). Written notice of a proposed objection and the grounds on which it is made must be sent to the auditor at the address given above and copied to me at the address given below.
