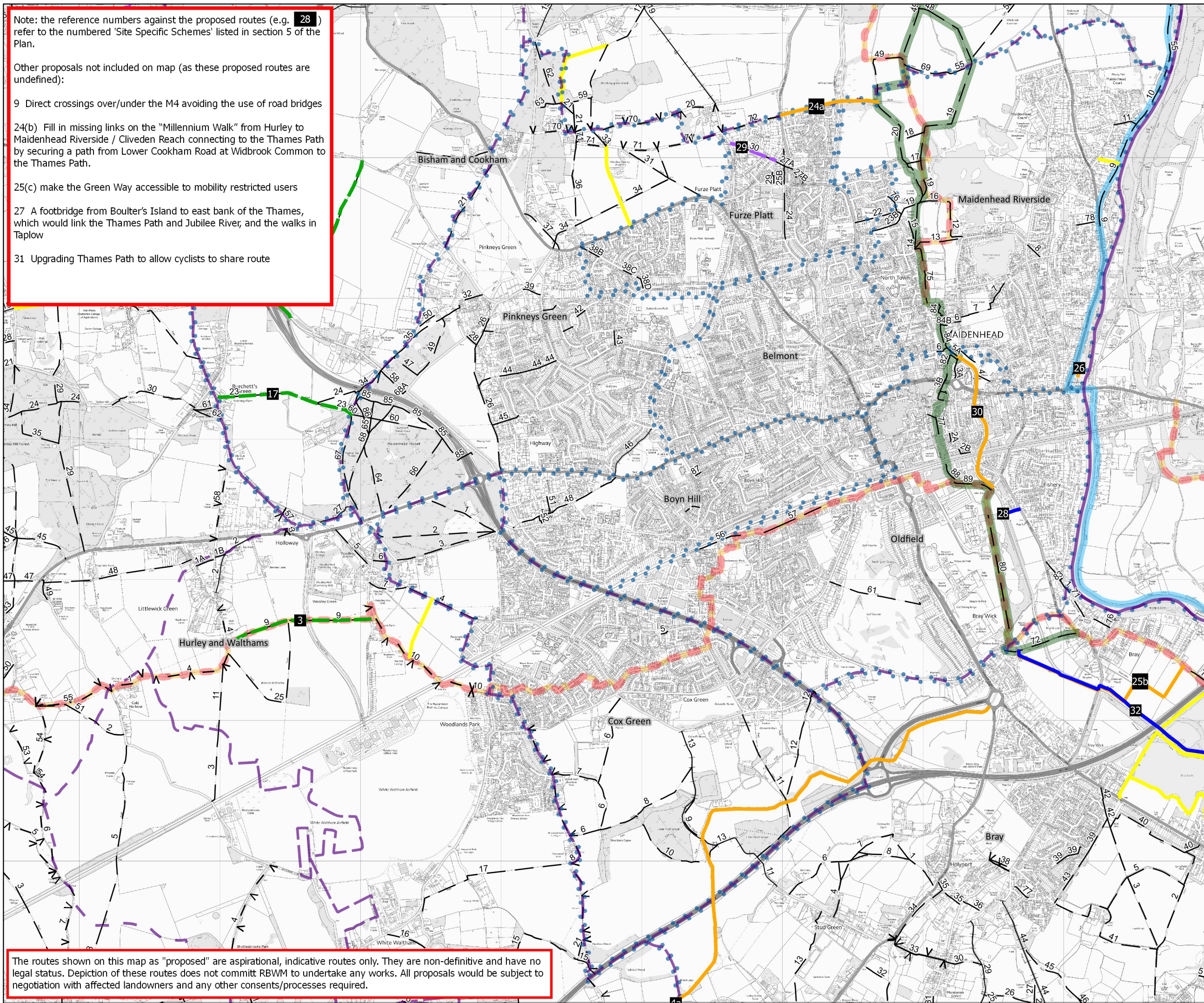
9 Direct crossings over/under the M4 avoiding the use of road bridges

25(c) make the Green Way accessible to mobility restricted users

27 A footbridge from Boulter's Island to east bank of the Thames, which would link the Thames Path and Jubilee River, and the walks in Taplow

31 Upgrading Thames Path to allow cyclists to share route

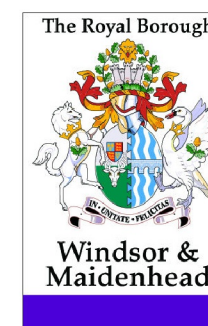
