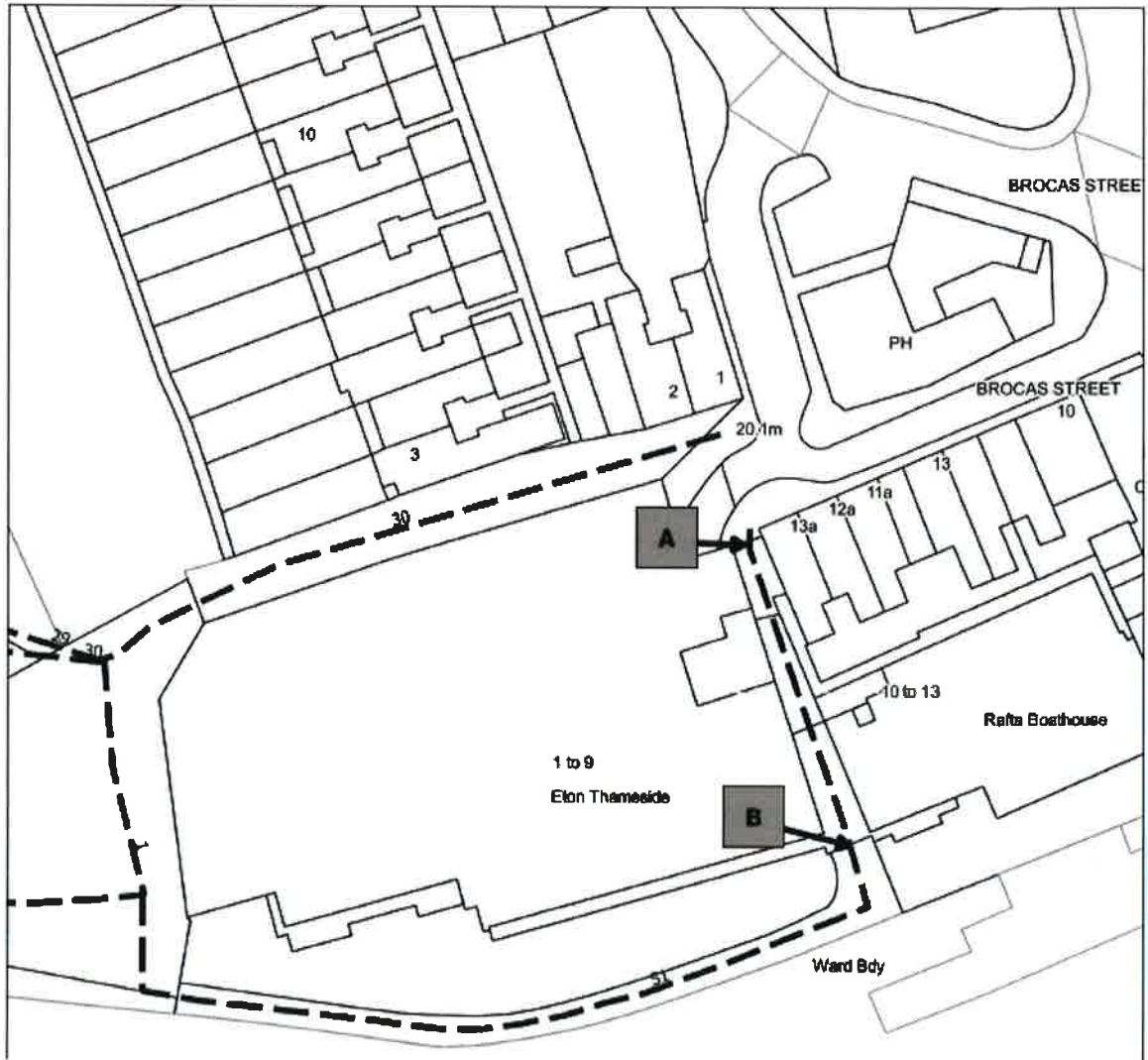
### PUBLIC FOOTPATH 51 ETON

### PUBLIC SPACES PROTECTION ORDER 2019

The Royal Borough of Windsor and Maidenhead ("the Council") in exercise of the powers under sections 59, 64 and 72 of the Anti-Social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014 ("the Act") and all other enabling powers, having had regard to the matters specified in Section 64(1) and being satisfied that the conditions set out in Section 59(1) and (2) and 64(2) of the Act have been met, Hereby Makes the following Order:

1. This Order shall be cited as the Royal Borough of Windsor and Maidenhead (Public Footpath 51 Eton) Public Spaces Protection Order 2019 and applies to the section of Public Footpath 51 Eton shown delineated by the black broken line running between Points A and B marked on the plan attached to this Order ("the Designated Area")
2. The effect of this Order shall be to restrict the public right of way over the Restricted Area between the hours of 22:00 and 05:00 daily and at all other times the public right of way shall not be obstructed and the gates erected thereon in pursuance of this Article shall be locked in an open position.
3. This Order authorises the installation, operation and maintenance of gates and an electronic locking system in the positions marked A and B on the plan attached to this Order to enable the restriction in Article 2 hereof to be enforced.
4. Responsibility for the maintenance and operation of the gates and the electronic locking system authorised by Article 3 hereof shall lie with Eton Thameside Management Company Ltd. ("the Management Company") or their appointed representative.
5. In the event of a mechanical breakdown of the electronic locking system, the gates authorised by Article 2 hereof shall be kept locked in an open position.
6. At all times the Management Company shall ensure that a current emergency contact telephone number is displayed on the gates at Points A and B and shall install at Points A and B a clear and visible emergency exit button for use by the public.
7. The Management Company shall provide the current PIN Code applicable for the electronic locking system to the Council, the Emergency Services and the Eton Town Council.
8. The restriction contained in Article 2 hereof shall not apply to occupiers and visitors to properties only accessed from the said Footpath.
9. This Order shall come into force on 28/11 2019 and shall continue in force thereafter for a period of 3 years.
10. Any person who, without reasonable excuse, fails to comply with the restriction contained in Article 2 hereof commits an offence and shall be liable, on summary conviction, to a fine not exceeding Level 3 on the Standard Scale.
11. Any interested person being an individual who lives in the vicinity of the Designated Area or who works in or regularly visits the said area wishing to question the validity of this Order on the grounds that the Council had no power to make it or that any requirements of the Act has not been complied with in relation to this Order may apply to the High Court within 6 weeks from the date on which this Order is made.
