

AUDIT OF ACCOUNTS YEAR ENDED 2019/20 – NOTICE OF PUBLIC RIGHTS

Local Audit and Accountability Act 2014, Sections 25 to 28

Accounts and Audit (England) Regulations 2015, Sections 10, 14, 15 and 17

The Council's accounts are subject to external audit by Deloitte LLP, 3 Victoria Square, Victoria Street, St Albans, AL1 3TF. Members of the public and local government electors have certain rights in the audit process:

1. From 3 August 2020 to 14 September 2020 between 9am and 4.45pm any person may inspect the accounts of the Council for the year ended 2019/20 and certain related documents (comprising books, deeds, contracts, bills, vouchers and receipts) at the address given below. They may also make copies of the accounts and documents.
2. From 3 August 2020 to 14 September 2020 a local government elector for the area of the Council, or his/her representative, may ask the auditor questions about the accounts. Please contact Jonathan Gooding, the auditor at the address given above, or email jgooding@deloitte.co.uk, to arrange to ask any questions.
3. From 3 August 2020 to 14 September 2020 a local government elector for the area of the Council, or his/her representative, may object to the Council's accounts (under section 27 of the Local Audit and Accountability Act 2014). Written notice of a proposed objection and the grounds on which it is made must be sent to the auditor at the address given above and copied to me at the address given below.
