2.	Update on M4 Smart Motorways	
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Due to ongoing controversy over smart motorways, the overall policy is subject to review by the Government and National Highways is working with the Department for Transport to respond to any changes. - The M4 smart motorway project is continuing as planned and progress of the scheme is on schedule. <p>M4 J8/9 to 12</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Currently 60mph across 3 lanes as no live (permanent) technology in place. - 3 lanes at 60mph, with full CCTV and free recovery, will remain in place until Stopped Vehicle Detection technology has been installed; this technology is in the testing and commissioning phase. 	

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The testing and commissioning phase is due to conclude in early December, at which point full smart motorway integrated systems will be live and the national speed limit will apply. - NB. 	<p>LEGOLAND Windsor Resort – Update & Key Dates:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The Park is open on selected dates through December for a limited, ticketed Christmas event which is pre-book only. - The Park will open for a February half term offering which will run over a 2-week period from 14th to 25th February. - Park will reopen for the main season around 13th March. - There is no big new attraction planned for next year, so 2022 will be a continuation of Mythica. <p>Bracknell Forest Council – Update & Key Dates:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Resurfacing for next year, nothing on the horizon that effects routes to LLW. <p>RBWM – Update & Key Dates:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - No major works planned. - Thursday 2nd to Sunday 5th June: Queen’s Platinum Jubilee celebrations will take place and there will likely be some disruption relating to this. - M4 J8/9 at Maidenhead: there are plans to do works on the A308/Braywick roundabout which could last up to 60 weeks.
