- 1. From Monday 3 July 2023 to Friday 11 August 2023 (inclusive) on weekdays between 9am and 4.45pm any interested person may inspect the accounts of the Council for the year ended 31 March 2023 and certain related documents (comprising books, deeds, contracts, bills, vouchers and receipts) at the address given below. They may also make copies of the accounts and documents.
- 2. From Monday 3 July 2023 to Friday 11 August 2023 (inclusive) a local government elector for the area of the Council, or his/her representative, may ask the auditor questions about the accounts. Please contact Jonathan Gooding, the auditor at the address given above, or email jgooding@deloitte.co.uk, to arrange to ask any questions.
- 3. From Monday 3 July 2023 to Friday 11 August 2023 (inclusive) a local government elector for the area of the Council, or his/her representative, may object to the Council's accounts (under section 27 of the Local Audit and Accountability Act 2014). Written notice of a proposed objection and the grounds on which it is made must be sent to the auditor at the address given above and copied to me at the address given below.

No objection may be made unless the auditor has previously received written notice of the proposed objection, specifying the facts on which the objector relies and the grounds on which the objection is being made. A copy of that written notice must also be sent to the Council at the address below.
