

# NOTICE OF REFERENDUM

## Maidenhead NEIGHBOURHOOD AREA

### Referendum on the adoption of the Maidenhead Neighbourhood Plan

**Thursday 19 March 2026**

1. A referendum will be held on **Thursday, 19 March 2026** to decide on the question below:

**‘Do you want the Royal Borough of Windsor and Maidenhead to use the Neighbourhood Plan for Maidenhead to help it decide planning applications in the neighbourhood area?’**

2. Electors not currently listed on the Register of Electors or those that have recently moved can make an application to be included on the register for this referendum. The application must be received by the Electoral Registration Officer no later than **Tuesday, 3 March 2026**. New applications for, or amendments or cancellations of postal votes and amendments or cancellation of existing proxy votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the address shown below by **5pm on Wednesday, 4 March 2026**. 4. New applications to vote by proxy at this referendum must be received by the Electoral Registration Officer at the address below **by 5pm on Wednesday, 11 March 2026**. Applications for a proxy vote may also be made online: [www.gov.uk/apply-proxy-vote](http://www.gov.uk/apply-proxy-vote)
5. Applications for a Voter Authority Certificate or an Anonymous Elector’s Document valid for this referendum must reach the Electoral Registration Officer **by 5pm on Wednesday, 11 March 2026**.
