3. If the election is contested, the poll will take place on Thursday 11 June 2026.

5. Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the address shown below by **5pm on Wednesday 27 May 2026**.
6. Applications for a Voter Authority Certificate or an Anonymous Elector's Document valid for this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by **5pm on Wednesday 3 June 2026**. 7. Applications to vote by proxy at this election must be received by the Electoral Registration Officer at the address given below by **5pm on Wednesday 3 June 2026**.
8. Applications to vote by emergency proxy on grounds of occupation, service or employment or a medical condition, illness or disability arising after **5pm on Wednesday 3 June 2026** is not later than **5pm on Thursday 11 June 2026**.
